1. Course Description

This course engages with the relationship between spiritual direction and the moral life. It comes out of the Catholic tradition, more specifically, from the moral and spiritual mindset of St. Alphonsus de Liguori, doctor of the Church, patron saint of confessors and moral theologians, and the founder of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. While not an exhaustive treatment of either spiritual direction or the moral life, the course examines the relationship between the two and, in the spirit of Alphonsus, does so in a way that is simple, practical, pastoral, focused on the poor and marginalized, engaging of other faith traditions, and easy to implement. It wishes to make sound spiritual direction accessible to as many people as possible and to offer it across boundaries that have often kept people divided, rather than united. As such, this course is intended as a practical primer for an approach to spiritual direction that looks to the future by reflecting on the past and learning how both impinge upon the decisions of the present.

2. Envisioned Learning Outcomes

- Students will demonstrate an understanding of the nature of spiritual direction and the connection to the moral life.
- Students will demonstrate an understanding of the moral and spiritual mindset of St. Alphonsus de Liguori.
- Students will demonstrate a capacity to engage in the work of spiritual direction according the model
 presented, engaging those within the Christian faith tradition and dialoguing with those within other faith
 traditions.

7. ABOUT YOUR PROFESSOR





How to Register for the Course in Four Easy Steps


1. Go to http://www.spiritualdirectors.world and click on "Get this course for \$50" - that'll take you to the Vimeo page.
