God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference - living one day at a time, enjoying one moment at a time, accepting the hardships as the pathway to peace, taking, as he did, this sinful world as it is, not as he did, this sinful world as it is, not as I would have it, trusting that he will make all things right if I surrender to his will - that I may be reasonably happy in this life and supremely happy with him forever.

Philip St. Romain, in *Reflecting on the Serenity Prayer*, was not able to find out how these two versions were evolved from Reinhold Niebuhr's original prayer.

I first saw points 1 - 3 of the "GUARANTEED STRESS BUSTER" on a bulkhead (*wall*) in a Navy ship's barbershop, and later added point 4.



PRIMACY of the UNIVERSE

May God grant that I speak with judgment and have thoughts worthy of what I have received, for he is the guide even of wisdom and the corrector of the wise. For both we and our words are in his hand, as are all understanding and skill in crafts.

For it is he who gave me unerring knowledge of what exists, to know the structure of the world and the activity of the elements; the beginning and end and middle of times, the alternations of the solstices and the changes of the seasons, the cycles of the year and the constellations of the stars, the natures of animals and the tempers of wild beasts, the powers of spirits and the reasonings of men, the varieties of plants and the virtues of roots; I learned both what is secret and what is manifest, for wisdom, the fashioner of all things, taught me.

For in her there is a spirit that is intelligent, holy, unique, manifold, subtle, mobile, clear, unpolluted, distinct, invulnerable, loving the good, keen, irresistible, beneficent, humane, steadfast, sure, free from anxiety, all-powerful, overseeing all, and penetrating through all spirits that are intelligent and pure and most subtle. For wisdom is more mobile than any motion; because of her pureness she pervades and penetrates all things. For she is a breath of the power of God, and a pure emanation of the glory of the Almighty; therefore nothing defiled gains entrance into her. For she is a reflection of eternal light, a spotless mirror of the working of God, and an image of his goodness.

Though she is but one, she can do all things, and while remaining in herself, she renews all things; in every generation she passes into holy souls and makes them friends of God, and prophets; for God loves nothing so much as the man who lives with wisdom. For she is more beautiful than the sun, and excels every constellation of the stars. Compared with the light she is found to be superior, for it is succeeded by the night, but against wisdom evil does not prevail. She reaches mightily from one end of the earth to the other, and she orders all things well (Wisdom 7:15-8:1). In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God ... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father (John 1:1,14).

He is the image of the invisible God, the first-born of all creation; for in him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or authorities - all things were created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. He is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning, the first-born from the dead, that in everything he might be pre-eminent.

For in him all the fulness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross. And you, who once were estranged and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds, he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, in order to present you holy and blameless and irreproachable before him, provided that you continue in the faith, stable and steadfast, not shifting from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which has been preached to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, became a minister (Colossians 1:15-23).

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places ... as a plan for the fulness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth (Ephesians 1:3,10).

CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH (CCC)


Christ and his Church thus together make up the "whole Christ" (*Christus totus*) [...] Head and members form as it were one and the same mystical person (CCC, 795).

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
Jesus said to the Holy Apostles: Go into all the world and preach the gospel to the whole creation (Mark 16:15).

The Title:

HEART OF CHRIST'S MYSTICAL BODY

This title is may be the first time to use this description.

Your and other's heart, when in the state of grace, is united in the Heart of Christ's Mystical Body.

Jesus is the Head of the Mystical Body (see Colossians 1:18). Christ, says St. Paul, the Apostle, is the Head of the Body of the Church.

We see Pope Pius XII writing in the Encyclical Mystical Body of Christ (Mystici Corporis Christi): The Body of Christ are united with their Head (nn. 11, 14).

A head may be a represent the intellect. Of course, Jesus is the Head of the Body of the Church.

And / both we may represent the heart.

"The spiritual tradition of the Church also emphasizes the *heart*, in the biblical sense of the depths of one's being," where a person decides (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC], paragraph 368).

Sacred Scripture is a "reason of the unity of God's plan, of which Christ Jesus is the center and heart (...); we understand the phrase "heart of Christ" (see CCC, 112).

Others hearts are united in the One Heart of Christ's Mystical Body.

The Lines:

SACRED HEART OF JESUS, HAVE MERCY ON US.

A traditional short prayer.

Christ "has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation" (CCC, 478).

Jesus joined Mary of Nazareth with his sacrifice in her mother's heart (CCC, 964).

This may be the first use of this term for praying.

Saint Joseph is silent in the Gospels.

HAND DOWN HEARTS OF THE HOLY APOSTLES, PRAY FOR US,

This may be the first use of this term for praying.

"Hand down" is an idiom passing to others.

The Holy Apostles hand down Jesus' teachings (Apostles' Creed).

POVERELLO'S THE KINGDOM OF GOD, PRAY FOR US.

This may be the first use of this term for praying.

"Poverello" is a nickname for Saint Francis of Assisi. It is famous calling him as the poor one.

We see the Beatitudes (Sermon of the Mount; Matthew 5:3).

St. Francis is a model of the poor in spirit. The poor in spirit have the kingdom of heaven.

THE PURE IN HEART, PRAY FOR US.

Matthew 5:8 refers it.

This may be the first use of this term for praying.

Temperance is a classical cardinal virtue.

Perhaps, see and pray with other phrases similar "THE SINCERE HEARTS", "THE UPRIGHT HEARTS", "THE GENTLE HEARTS", and "THE BROKENHEARTED, PRAY FOR US"!

GRAFTING HEARTS, WE TEACH AND ASK UNITED IN THE LORD JESUS.

This may be the first use of this term for praying.

"Grafting" referred to the True Vine in the Gospel (John 15:5).

We teach because, "The Word became flesh to make us partakers of the divine nature" (CCC, 460; 2 Peter 1:4).

We ask because, "it will be given to you; seek and you will find" (Mt 7:7) whatever (Jn 16:23).

Perhaps would be useful to study about Eusebius of Caesarea, Saint Jerome, the given name Miriam, the name of Mary, Ave Maria, Stella Maris, and confer Saint Faustina's Divine Mercy in My Soul (*Diary*, 432) and in other places.


> Be immersed in fathomless Divine Mercy like a drop of water in the ocean.

* Some biblical scholars have seen in it the Hebrew words mar (bitter) and yam (sea). This first meaning can refer to Mary's bitter suffering at the cross and her many tears of sorrow.

Another interpretation of the word mar renders Mary's name to mean "drop of the sea" and St. Jerome rendered it in Latin as stilla maris, which was later changed to stella (star) maris. This accounts for a popular title for Mary as "Star of the Sea".

Furthermore, perhaps study for the Pole Star (Polaris, North Star, polar star, polestar), which was related with earlier Marian veneration.



OUR LADY of MOUNT CARMEL = STELLA MARIS

The veneration of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, often is associated with the devotion of her title Stella Maris.

As seen, the Brown Scapular is not holding here, rather the Carmelite's coat of arms, which includes stars.

Perhaps, a star there recalls the relationship with Our Lady, Star of the Sea; as we know the sanctuary Stella Maris in Mount Carmel.

The MOTHER of GOD

is the source of all her titles.

Words have limitations. These "lifesaver" and "beacon" are catalysts for devotion to her.



The Magi from the East followed the Child's star.

The Mother of God has a title STELLA MARIS | the STAR of the SEA.

We follow her.

In our lives, we become overwhelm in the waves of our lives.

We look to her as a lifesaver for us.

Our Mother is a beacon beckons to: The lamp is the Lamb.

* "The lamp is the Lamb" (Revelation 21:23).

SPIRITUAL NAVIGATION

Navigators speak of a "three point fix" in order to be able a reliable position on a chart. It is when three distances intersect themselves.

In a discernment is a "spiritual triangulation".

Spiritually also needs to intersect three points together.

For finding your correct position after ponder:

1. God's objective moral law, revealed in Sacred Scripture, Tradition and a legitimate magisterium;

2. God arranges providentially in situations; and

3. the testimony of your own informed conscience and inner peace.

By lining up all three points at the same time is to be prudent. It is the only way to stay as close to the course as we need.

If in a decision giving ALONE:

- a) Objective law alone is to run aground on LEGALISM.
- b) Situations alone is to drift aimlessly into RELATIVISM.
- c) Individual conscience alone is to sink into SUBJECTIVISM.

In the event: "To navigate is precise; to live is not precise."

We need all the help in the voyage of life!



SAINT PETER WALKED on the WATER Matthew 14:22-36

Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus.

(...) he became frightened; and, beginning to sink (...)

(...) Peter cried out in an act, "LORD, SAVE ME!" Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and caught him (...)

What happened when Peter was caught, before he got into the boat?

After sinking: Did Peter became a playing ball, which Jesus had caught? Did Peter became a hauling fish, whom did Jesus dragged to the boat? Did Peter walk on water, after his act of faith?

The miserable condemned prisoners aboard the galleys were especially the least ... targets for opportunities to receive spiritual and corporal works of mercy.


They endured in various circumstances: damp dungeons ... chains on their legs ... only black bread and water ... covered with vermin and ulcers ... more repulsive conditions!

THE NAVY LINK

SAINT ELIZABETH ANN SETON was canonized in September 14, 1975 by Pope Paul VI. Shortly the then Chief of Navy Chaplains, Monsignor John J. O'-Connor (formerly John Cardinal O'Connor, the Archbishop of New York) took the initiative to proclaim Mother Seton "PATRONESS OF THE SEA SERVICES" for Catholic men and women in uniform the Navy, the Marine Corps, the Coast Guard, and the Merchant Marine. Admiral James D. Watkins, then Chief of Naval Personnel, collaborated closely with Rear Admiral O'Connor in that effort and in 1977 they struck a medal honoring Mother Seton because of her link to the Navy through her two sons, William and Richard.

* * * * * * * * * * *

William Seton was appointed Midshipman on the fourth of July in 1817. In February of 1818 he reported for duty aboard the USS *INDEPENDENCE*, and in July he was assigned to the USS *MACEDONIAN* which sailed from Boston later in the year on a cruise around Cape Horn to Valparaiso, Chile. While he was on this voyage, his mother died on January 4, 1821. In May of 1822 he was ordered to the USS *CYANE*. This voyage in the Mediterranean and along the coast of Africa lasted more than three years. Late in February of 1826 he was given his commission as Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy. In November he was ordered to the Sloop of War *HORNET* which was sent from Norfolk, Virginia to cruise the West Indian waters in search of pirates. He resigned as Lieutenant on July 5 of 1834, almost seventeen years to the day he was appointed Midshipman.

* * * * * * * * * * *

Richard Seton, the second son, was the Captain's clerk on the USS *CYANE*. The Navy has very little information to give about Richard Seton. For almost a year (June 1822 to April 1823), he was on duty with this ship off the coast of Africa, where the United States Government was supporting the American Colonizing Society in its efforts to found a free Negro Colony in Liberia. In a letter from the Reverend Jehudi Ashmun, an Episcopalian missionary in the area, we learn that Richard contracted a fatal fever while nursing the minister back to life. Shortly afterwards, Richard Seton died of this fever on June 26 of 1823 and was buried at sea.



Saint John Bosco's Vision of Two Pillars: Holy Eucharist and Our Lady







The great Doctor of the Church St. Augustine of Hippo spent over 30 years working on his treatise De Trinitate [about the Holy Trinity], endeavoring to conceive an intelligible explanation for the mystery of the Trinity.

The Vision of St. Augustine

St. Augustine was walking by the seashore one day contemplating the mystery of the Holy Trinity when he saw a little child running back and forth from the water to a spot on the seashore. The boy was using a shell to carry water from the large ocean and pour it into a small pit that he had made in the sand.

Augustine came up to him and asked him what he was doing.

"I'm going to pour the entire ocean into this hole," the boy replied.

"What?" said Augustine. "That is impossible, my dear child, the sea is so great and the shell and the hole are so little."

"That is true," the boy said. "It would be easier and quicker to draw all the water out of the sea and fit it into this hole than for you to fit the mystery of the Trinity and His Divinity into your little intellect; for the Mystery of the Trinity is greater and larger in comparison with your intelligence than is this vast ocean in comparison with this little hole."

And then the child vanished.

What does it mean?

Some say that St. Augustine had been talking with an angel sent by God to teach him a lesson on intellectual pride. Others say it was the Christ Child Himself who came to remind Augustine of the limits of human understanding in relation to the great mysteries of our Faith.



The Sea Shell Because of this story, the sea shell has become a symbol of St. Augustine and the study of theology.





INCARNATION and the IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

Blessed Duns Scotus, the Subtle Doctor and the Doctor of Mary Immaculate, wrote about the subject "**Primacy of Christ**."

GOD'S PLAN was before the creation of time. In the marvelous providence, the 2nd Person of the Trinity would become in the **INCARNATION** and become the Head of creation. So, we have a phrase: Primacy of Christ!

See the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) paragraphs 518, 1138 and cross-references about the mystery of recapitulation/the Primacy of Christ.

All things in heaven and on earth are united in the Lord Jesus, who is the pinnacle of all creation.

As a plan to unite all things in Jesus, things in all the Universe (see Ephesians 1:10); united in the Lord Jesus, who is the head of the body, the church and preeminent of everything (Colossians 1:18).

"GOD'S PLAN" is an article by Eusebe Menard, O.F.M. in the MSA archives (God 10).

In his library is a book titled "La Royauté univereselle du Sacré-Coeur l'Immaculée de Marie d'apres la doctrine du Bienheureux Jean Duns Scot" - *Les Vox Franciscaines;* P. Sigismond, OM Cap., 1925 ["The Sacred Heart's Universal Kingship and Mary's Immaculate Conception according the doctrine of Blessed John Duns Scotus"].


Blessed Duns Scotus, the Doctor of Mary Immaculate, wrote about the subject "Primacy of Christ." It was not popular. Historically, the 2nd Person of the Trinity was born to redeem us from sins. So we listen to the song Exultant in the Easter Vigil Liturgy for the "happy fault."

Scotus concluded that sin should not be necessarily for the Incarnation.

Many disagreed with Scotus and posed the question, "Why challenge his idea when in fact, sin happened?"

The Franciscan Scotist position was avoided for about 700 years. Finally in the 20th century, the Franciscans changed their opponents' question into a declaration statement: "**God's Plan** was before time. In the marvelous providence, the 2nd Person of the Trinity would become Incarnate and become the Head of creation. So, we have the Primacy of Christ!"

The diagram of **GOD'S PLAN** shows Mary, the Mother of God, which makes implicit Scotus' teaching about the Immaculate Conception; however, is explicitly in these pages.


