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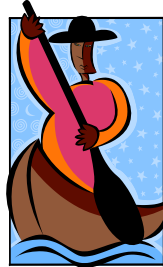
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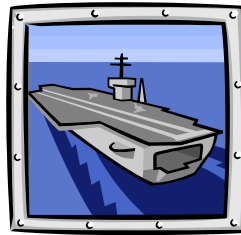
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About:

**The white background stood for peace, the gold star for hope,
and "Inasmuch" referenced the biblical quote
that was the motto of the entire campaign:**

**"inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of my brethren,
you have done it unto Me."**

Note: The United States of America was in the Great War after 1917.

**"The USS *Jason* was going into an area at war. Government officials made necessary
arrangements to assure the safety of the ship, its crew and contents." Before its departure,
at November 14, 1914, the U.S. Acting Secretary of State, "confirmed what had been agreed
to with all foreign representatives of the United States."**

SAINT AUGUSTINE and THE MERCY OCEAN

The great Doctor of the Church St. Augustine of Hippo spent over 30 years working on his treatise De Trinitate [about the Holy Trinity], endeavoring to conceive an intelligible explanation for the mystery of the Trinity.

The Vision of St. Augustine

St. Augustine was walking by the seashore one day contemplating the mystery of the Holy Trinity when he saw a little child running back and forth from the water to a spot on the seashore. The boy was using a shell to carry water from the large ocean and pour it into a small pit that he had made in the sand.

Augustine came up to him and asked him what he was doing.

“I’m going to pour the entire ocean into this hole,” the boy replied.

“What?” said Augustine. “That is impossible, my dear child, the sea is so great and the shell and the hole are so little.”

“That is true,” the boy said. “It would be easier and quicker to draw all the water out of the sea and fit it into this hole than for you to fit the mystery of the Trinity and His Divinity into your little intellect; for the Mystery of the Trinity is greater and larger in comparison with your intelligence than is this vast ocean in comparison with this little hole.”

And then the child vanished.

What does it mean?

Some say that St. Augustine had been talking with an angel sent by God to teach him a lesson on intellectual pride. Others say it was the Christ Child Himself who came to remind Augustine of the limits of human understanding in relation to the great mysteries of our Faith.



The Sea Shell

Because of this story,
the sea shell has become a symbol of St. Augustine and the study of theology.

The article above is based on the story in the “Golden Legend”, written in A. D. 1275 by Jacobus de Voragine, Archbishop of Genoa via Our Lady of Mercy Lay Carmelite Community.

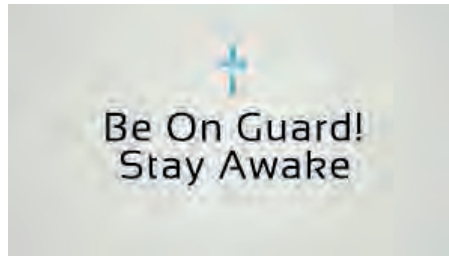

Vincent consoled the sorrowful, defended the rights of orphans and generously aided widows; whatever he did for the least, he did for Jesus.

The miserable condemned prisoners aboard the galleys were especially the least ... targets for opportunities to receive spiritual and corporal works of mercy.

They endured in various circumstances: damp dungeons ... chains on their legs ... only black bread and water ... covered with vermin and ulcers ... more repulsive conditions!

In any event, his legacy includes that King Louis XIII appointed him the royal almoner of the galleys.

SPIRITUAL NAVIGATION

Navigators speak of a "three point fix" in order to be able a reliable position on a chart. It is when three distances intersect themselves.

In a discernment is a "spiritual triangulation".

Spiritually also needs to intersect three points together.

For finding your correct position after ponder:

- 1. God's objective moral law, revealed in Sacred Scripture, Tradition and a legitimate magisterium;**
- 2. God arranges providentially in situations; and**
- 3. the testimony of your own informed conscience and inner peace.**

By lining up all three points at the same time is to be prudent.

It is the only way to stay as close to the course as we need.

If in a decision giving ALONE:

- a) Objective law alone is to run aground on LEGALISM.**
- b) Situations alone is to drift aimlessly into RELATIVISM.**
- c) Individual conscience alone is to sink into SUBJECTIVISM.**

In the event: "To navigate is precise; to live is not precise."

We need all the help in the voyage of life!

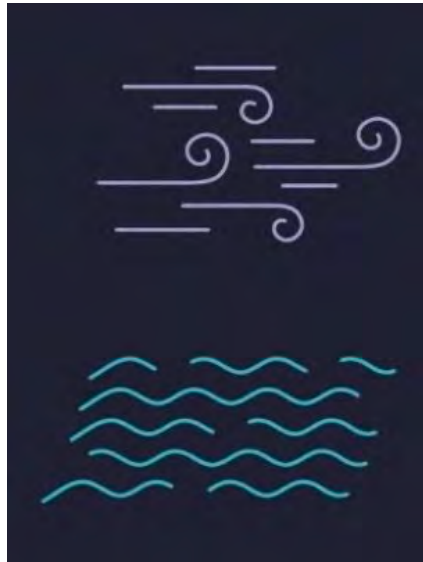
MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS

STILLA MARIS

A Drop of the Sea*

The Blessed Virgin Mary has various titles and here are two:

STELLA MARIS - the Star of the Sea.

STILLA MARIS - a Drop of the Sea.

Perhaps would be useful to study about Eusebius of Caesarea, Saint Jerome, the given name Miriam, the name of Mary, Ave Maria, Stella Maris, and confer Saint Faustina's Divine Mercy in My Soul (*Diary*, 432) and in other places.

Be immersed in fathomless Divine Mercy
like a drop of water in the ocean.

HOLY MARY,
a Drop of the Sea,
pray for us.

*** Some biblical scholars have seen in it the Hebrew words mar (bitter) and yam (sea). This first meaning can refer to Mary's bitter suffering at the cross and her many tears of sorrow.**

Another interpretation of the word mar renders Mary's name to mean "drop of the sea" and St. Jerome rendered it in Latin as stilla maris, which was later changed to stella (star) maris. This accounts for a popular title for Mary as "Star of the Sea".

Furthermore, perhaps study for the Pole Star (Polaris, North Star, polar star, polestar), which was related with earlier Marian veneration.



OUR LADY of MOUNT CARMEL = STELLA MARIS

The veneration of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, often is associated with the devotion of her title Stella Maris.

The Brown Scapular holding here, has the Carmelite's coat of arms, which includes stars.

Perhaps, a star there recalls the relationship with Our Lady, Star of the Sea; as we know the sanctuary Stella Maris in Mount Carmel.

The MOTHER of GOD

is the source of all her titles.

**Words have limitations.
These “lifesaver” and “beacon”
are catalysts for devotion to her.**



The Magi from the East followed the Child’s star.

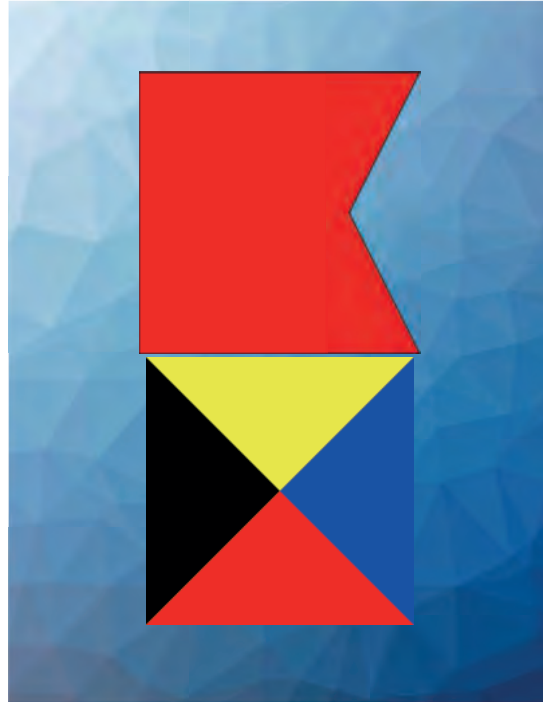

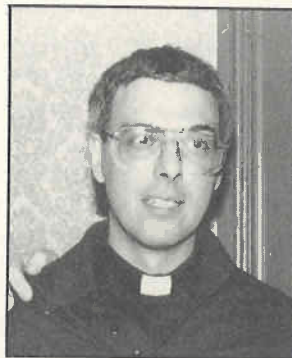

Ordonné prêtre par Mgr Laurent Guibord, O.F.M., Vicaire apostolique de Saint Joseph de l'Amazone, au Pérou, dans la chapelle du Séminaire des Saints-Apôtres à Cromwell, Connecticut, le 22 février 1984, j'ai quitté les États-Unis le 17 mars, le jour de la Saint Patrice, à destination d'Iquitos, Pérou, où je suis arrivé le 19 mars, fête de Saint Joseph, le patron du Vicariat qui m'accueillait comme missionnaire, pour assister à l'ouverture de l'Assemblée annuelle du Vicariat apostolique Saint-Joseph de l'Amazone. J'ai vécu mes deux premières semaines en Amazonie... en réunions. Tout se passait en espagnol, comme il se doit, et, moi, je ne comprenais pas encore la langue. Je me sentais plongé dans un tunnel où l'on ne perçoit la moindre lueur.

Mgr Guibord m'a envoyé travailler à Pevas aux côtés de missionnaires chevronnés. Pevas? Ne cherchez pas Pevas sur votre carte du Pérou, à moins que vous n'en possédiez une très détaillée. Dire tout simplement que Pevas se trouve à l'autre bout du monde, c'est m'exprimer avec modération. Pevas se trouve sur la berge de la rivière Ampiyacu qui coule dans le fleuve Amazone à une centaine de mètres du village. Pevas, c'est une petite localité d'à peu près 1 500 âmes. La paroisse de l'Immaculée-Conception dépasse les limites du village pour s'étendre amplement et abriter quelque 10 000 autres fidèles dont la plupart vivent dans des hameaux d'une cinquantaine de personnes. La plus éloignée des localités que nous desservons se trouve à 4 heures de Pe-

YOU

TOTALLY or PARTIALLY?

Saint Francis of Assisi would poetically charitably say: YOU are the Brother Ass?

Father E. H. Menard, O.F.M., the founder of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles (M.S.A.) would similarly say about a problematic person - a mule - in our community, that if you thrown out that person, that will result, that we would receive a worse one!

St. John Berchmans, S.J., (Nov. 26, Proper Calendar of the Society of Jesus) would say, "My penance is to live the common life ... I will pay (...) to the least inspiration of God."

In a paraphrase one, he was trying to say this:

COMMUNITY WAS MY WORSE SUFFERING.

Father Menard spoke about the MULES / the difficult persons.

Yes, mules are stubborn; YET, they are better being persevere on their self thinking, not a taskmaster; that is why some drivers, are used their whips in too times, and they shaved some hair on the mules' back; the shave shown the bared skin to be sensitive; it is these drivers were called "mule-skinners."

A mule is better, not a hard head; they are better than horses because they have HARD HOOVES and have a better "sure foot" than a horse; a mule carries more heavy loads, more stamina, endurance, more resistant of insects and rain inclement, patient in some heavy loads than a donkey or a horse.

Bigger problems sometimes being a person to be a mule / a PEST to others.

If any person has heavy loads, then plow with Jesus' yoke, and carry as being a partaker of divinity.

Many said that Community - or any person's quirks replaces the sufferings of Purgatory, which is in your circumstances that is is your Cross. As TRYING to DO the council of the Serenity Prayer. Being with your mule, bear wrongs patiently.

Father Menard, this Franciscan, is the principal founder of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles (M.S.A.).

Father honored "SCOTUS" for named the principal hall in the Missionaries' General House campus in Ricardo Palma, Peru.

The basis of these followed pages were founded in the archives of the Missionaries.

The diagrams of God's plan are predated 1984. After many years, the English version was published in the section "God's Plan" in the book: *The Mercy Ocean*.

Those drawings did not use the words "Primacy of Christ" or the "Recapitulation of Christ".

Yet, see the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (CCC); 2nd Edition:

Everything is RECAPITULATED in Christ

(n. 2748; and several notes there)

Confer:

**GOD'S Plan
in the diagrams
show without words about the
Primacy of Christ.**

"as a plan for the fullness of times, to sum up all things in Christ, in heaven and on earth."

(Ephesians 1:10)

Note: Father Menard reflects / honors Blessed Scotus' / Franciscans' idea of the "Primacy of Christ" / in Jesus' whole life is a mystery of recapitulation (confer CCC n. 518) for our ORIGINAL VOCATION.

Now, we follow thus ...

INCARNATION *and the* **IMMACULATE CONCEPTION**

Blessed Duns Scotus, the Subtle Doctor and the Doctor of Mary Immaculate, wrote about the subject “**Primacy of Christ.**”

GOD’S PLAN was before the creation of time. In the marvelous providence, the 2nd Person of the Trinity would become in the **INCARNATION** and become the Head of creation. So, we have a phrase: Primacy of Christ!

See the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) paragraphs 518, 1138 and cross-references about the mystery of recapitulation/the Primacy of Christ.

All things in heaven and on earth are united in the Lord Jesus, who is the pinnacle of all creation.

As a plan to unite all things in Jesus, things in all the Universe (see Ephesians 1:10); united in the Lord Jesus, who is the head of the body, the church and preeminent of everything (Colossians 1:18).

In the mystery of the Incarnation, the fruit of Mary’s womb was being from her Immaculate flesh.

The Holy Spirit proceeds eternally from one principle and through one spiration (CCC 246). Perhaps, another title of the Holy Spirit is: “***The Original Immaculate Conception***”. Mary was an **incarnated** Immaculate Conception. She, the Spouse of the Holy Spirit, offered herself, which the baby’s Body was **incarnated from her Immaculate flesh!**



GOD'S PLAN
PRIMACY of CHRIST

"**GOD'S PLAN**" is an article by Eusebe Menard, O.F.M. in the MSA archives.

In his library is a book titled "La Royauté univereselle du Sacré-Coeur l'Immaculée de Marie d'après la doctrine du Bienheureux Jean Duns Scot" - *Les Vox Franciscaines*; P. Sigismund, OM Cap., 1925 ["The Sacred Heart's Universal Kingship and Mary's Immaculate Conception according the doctrine of Blessed John Duns Scotus"].

Blessed Duns Scotus, the Doctor of Mary Immaculate, wrote about the subject "Primacy of Christ." It was not popular. Historically, the 2nd Person of the Trinity was born to redeem us from sins. So we listen to the song Exultant in the Easter Vigil Liturgy for the "happy fault."

Scotus concluded that sin should not be necessarily for the Incarnation.

Many disagreed with Scotus and posed the question, "Why challenge his idea when in fact, sin happened?"

The Franciscan Scotist position was avoided for about 700 years. Finally in the 20th century, the Franciscans changed their opponents' question into a declaration statement: "**God's Plan** was before time. In the marvelous providence, the 2nd Person of the Trinity would become Incarnate and become the Head of creation. So, we have the Primacy of Christ!"
