

Reverend Father Eusèbe-Henri Marie Ménard and *Menard's Mules*

In the beginning, the title of these vignettes recalls Pope Francis in his Encyclical <u>Dilexit Nos</u>: "in this age of artificial intelligence, we cannot forget that poetry and love are necessary to save our humanity."

The title, hopefully you didn't realize, it is for an egotistical boast: "Me, me, me ..." It is for a catalyst to honor a person, whom aims this: BLESSED BE GOD.

This title was meant, it is meaning, that those memories recall the warm thoughts that radiated from the nucleus of a loving human being: Eusèbe-Henri Ménard.

He was not a hard person in a negative way. He was in a hard working way: in his strong hands and in his human intellect. Note this Appendix in the article: *Artificial Intelligence its ...*.

He could not to be blind to know that community life has its different difficulties. As he spoke several times that problematic persons are called "mules". Basically, the early Missionaries remember his point about mules in community life. Father's lesson was in our spirituality. After many years, we are continuing to have opportunities to exercise the virtue: Love, Love, Love.

After years, yet we never read anything explicitly about the mules; yes, we heard them; the "mules" were implicitly, in the barn, yet they were explicitly in the field of community life.

So the essential points of the muleMSA was finally wrote in an article, which is archived somewhere and is now in its Appendix. The article is with the name:

Menard's Mules.

This vignette ends the front cover of the English edition of the book, that Fr. Menard give personally to myself, as he did AND FOR MANY. These last three words are in the consecration of the Lord's Supper.



MSA Co-founders

The Society of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles (M.S.A.) Constitution, Article 210 states:

"In our Society an important place is given to Mr. Hector Durand, co-founder of the Work of the Holy Apostles." Also, there is a footnote there, which includes part of a quote from Fr.Menard's letter July 22, 1971 to Mr. Durand: "(...) and you have given both your life and your possessions in order to give priests to the world. I have always considered it a great privilege to have given you my collaboration."

Note this honor: The tombstones of Fr. Menard and Mr. Durand are together.



Furthermore, in the past, Father Menard in several presentations to the Society similarly said:

"YOU are a co-founder of the Works of the Holy Apostles."

This page here is a testimonial that: I personally heard that.

Additionally, this states:

Father Addison "Tad" Hallock, M.S.A. heard it, at least two times, that Father Menard, basically proclaimed the similarity quote: "You are co-founders of the Works of the Holy Apostles."

Statues

As Fr. Menard and myself were visiting the headquarters of the Rogationists religious congregation in Rome. We walking alone and as passed a statue of St. Hannibal Mary Di Francia, their founder. Fr. Menard, exclaimed as similarly these words: "We" - the Missionaries - "should have not make a statue of myself".

I always remembered that. Father was not against statues/icons/et cetera for himself; it was just a humble act, and of course he honored statues.

In God's plan, Father Menard became the Missionaries General Animator (aka Superior) Emeritus.


I had positions in the Missionaries' General Council.

BLESSED JOHN DUNS SCOTUS

M.Ss.A. Spirituality is closely linked to Bl. Scotus. A study of the personal library, and the writings of our beloved Founder, a Franciscan, would tell us so. Of this I am sure after working years in the General House. But, I know some of you are not even after you have read the various publications that have been sent you. This article is not meant to repeat all that has gone before. Rather, the matter is opened once again, some new thoughts may enter and hopefully you yourself will shed more light through your own relation with Bl. John Duns.

Among his Franciscan spirituality books Father Menard had "The Sacred Heart's Universal Kingship and Mary's Immaculate Conception according to the doctrine of Blessed John Duns Scotus". It was Scotus who so profetically fought for the Doctrine of the Immaculate Conception when the vast majority disagreed. The ridicule that Scotists suffered even gave rise to the English word "dunce"!

But was this just another book among Father's many? Then why did he himself write "The Mystery of the Heart of Jesus, according to the Franciscan School of Spirituality, particularly according to Duns Scotus"?

The interconnection of the Mystical Body of Christ, unrestricted by time, is seen in his reflection, as Fr. Menard relates that Jesus told St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, that she should study the life, works and spirituality of St. Francis, Model of devotion to his Sacred Heart. Of course, Bl. Scotus is the most illustrious representative of Franciscan thought.

Fr. Menard explains that God "who could have placed the Heart of Christ in Adam, instead put Adam, the Universe, the Angels, in a word, all in the Heart of Jesus." ²

BI. John Duns who? The subject of this page is a more illustrious character than most of us realize. At least 12 Pontiffs have recognized his special place among the Franciscans, and Paul VI wrote in the Apostolic Letter *Alma Parens* that "It is universally recognized that John Duns Scotus surpassed the Seraphic Doctor" (St.

Bonaventure) and that "St. Francis of Assisi's beautiful ideal of perfection is embedded in his (Scotus's) work and inflames it". St. Bernard of Clairvaux, St. Bonaventure and St. Thomas Aquinas did not favor the idea of Mary's Immaculate Conception. Aquinas even wrote: "The Blessed Virgin did indeed contract original sin, but was cleansed therefrom before her birth from the womb" (Summa Theologica III, 27, 2, ad2).

It was BI. John who championed the Immaculate Conception of Mary! This Doctrine is linked to the Primacy of Christ because the Blessed Mother participated in the original Plan of God before the "felix culpa".

Another Franciscan, working under the guidance of an Apostolic delegate, realized the connection between Duns Scotus and modern scientific thought⁴, a sign of the times for the M.Ss.A. as the third millennium draws near.

May each M.Ss.A. reflect on "how excellent the Lord made you for he created and formed you to the image of his beloved son according to the body, and to his own likeness according to the spirit" (Admonitions, N^a . 5 - J.D.S.). Blessed John Duns Scotus pray for us . . .



As, E. Menard, O.F.M., the founder of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles (M.S.A.) fondly recalled the Mystical Body of Christ, as we echo "Saint" Jaw, to reflect the Heart of Christ's Mystical Body, which is beating from the great cloud of witnesses (confer Hebrews 12:1).

Father E. H. Menard, O.F.M., the founder of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles (M.S.A.) would say something about a problematic person, as like a stubborn mule.
