ITS HISTORY

So THE SEA LORD'S BOOKSHELF would for a project to develop spirituality in a nautical setting.

Stavridis' other book: SAILING TRUE NORTH focused ten admirals. We admired their characters. It was born from David Brooks' THE ROAD TO CHARACTER.


The ship sailed from New York to deliver its cargo, of gifts to European children during the First World War.

The ship, the USS JASON, a collier, which usually transports coal. It wasn't carrying coal for stuffers of Santa's stockings!

The vessel became to have a nickname:

The Christmas Ship.

A pennant for it was named
"THE FLAG OF PEACE"
as we see below:



It was described as this:
"'The Flag of Peace' in green, a gold star and
"INASMUCH" green.

The white background stood for peace, the gold star for hope, and "Inasmuch" referenced the biblical quote that was the motto of the entire campaign: "inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of my brethren, you have done it unto Me."

(Matthew 25:40)

Note: The United States of America was in the Great War after 1917.

"The USS Jason was going into an area at war. Government officials made necessary arrangements to assure the safety of the ship, its crew and contents." Before its departure, at November 14, 1914, the U.S. Acting Secretary of State, "confirmed what had been agreed to with all foreign representatives of the United States."
