Canticle of the Sun

Francis of Assisi; 1225

PRIMACY of the UNIVERSE

May God grant that I speak with judgment and have thoughts worthy of what I have received, for he is the guide even of wisdom and the corrector of the wise. For both we and our words are in his hand, as are all understanding and skill in crafts.

For it is he who gave me unerring knowledge of what exists, to know the structure of the world and the activity of the elements; the beginning and end and middle of times, the alternations of the solstices and the changes of the seasons, the cycles of the year and the constellations of the stars, the natures of animals and the tempers of wild beasts, the powers of spirits and the reasonings of men, the varieties of plants and the virtues of roots; I learned both what is secret and what is manifest, for wisdom, the fashioner of all things, taught me.

For in her there is a spirit that is intelligent, holy, unique, manifold, subtle, mobile, clear, unpolluted, distinct, invulnerable, loving the good, keen, irresistible, beneficent, humane, steadfast, sure, free from anxiety, all-powerful, overseeing all, and penetrating through all spirits that are intelligent and pure and most subtle. For wisdom is more mobile than any motion; because of her pureness she pervades and penetrates all things. For she is a breath of the power of God, and a pure emanation of the glory of the Almighty; therefore nothing defiled gains entrance into her. For she is a reflection of eternal light, a spotless mirror of the working of God, and an image of his goodness. Though she is but one, she can do all things, and while remaining in herself, she renews all things; in every generation she passes into holy souls and makes them friends of God, and prophets; for God loves nothing so much as the man who lives with wisdom. For she is more beautiful than the sun, and excels every constellation of the

stars. Compared with the light she is found to be superior, for it is succeeded by the night, but against wisdom evil does not prevail. She reaches mightily from one end of the earth to the other, and she orders all things well (Wisdom 7:15-8:1).

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God ... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father (John 1:1,14).

He is the image of the invisible God, the first-born of all creation; for in him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or authorities - all things were created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. He is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning, the first-born from the dead, that in everything he might be pre-eminent.

For in him all the fulness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross. And you, who once were estranged and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds, he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, in order to present you holy and blameless and irreproachable before him, provided that you continue in the faith, stable and steadfast, not shifting from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which has been preached to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, became a minister (Colossians 1:15-23).

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places ... as a plan for the fulness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth (Ephesians 1:3,10).

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CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH (CCC)

Christ is the head of the body, the Church. He is the principle of creation and redemption. Raised to the Father's glory, in everything he [is] preeminent, especially in the Church, through whom he extends his reign over all things (CCC, paragraph 792).

Christ and his Church thus together make up the “whole Christ” (*Christus totus*) [...] Head and members form as it were one and the same mystical person (CCC, 795).

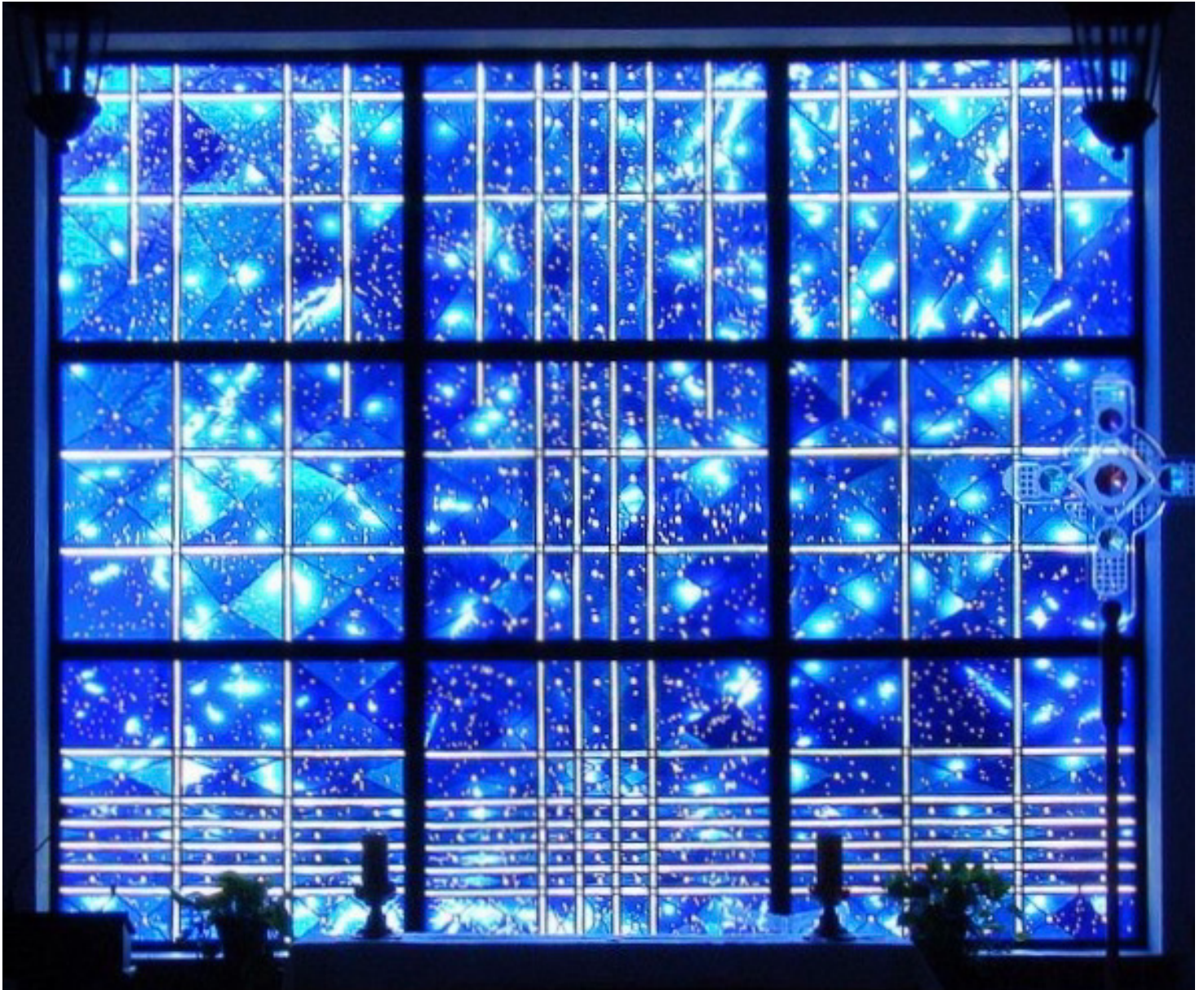

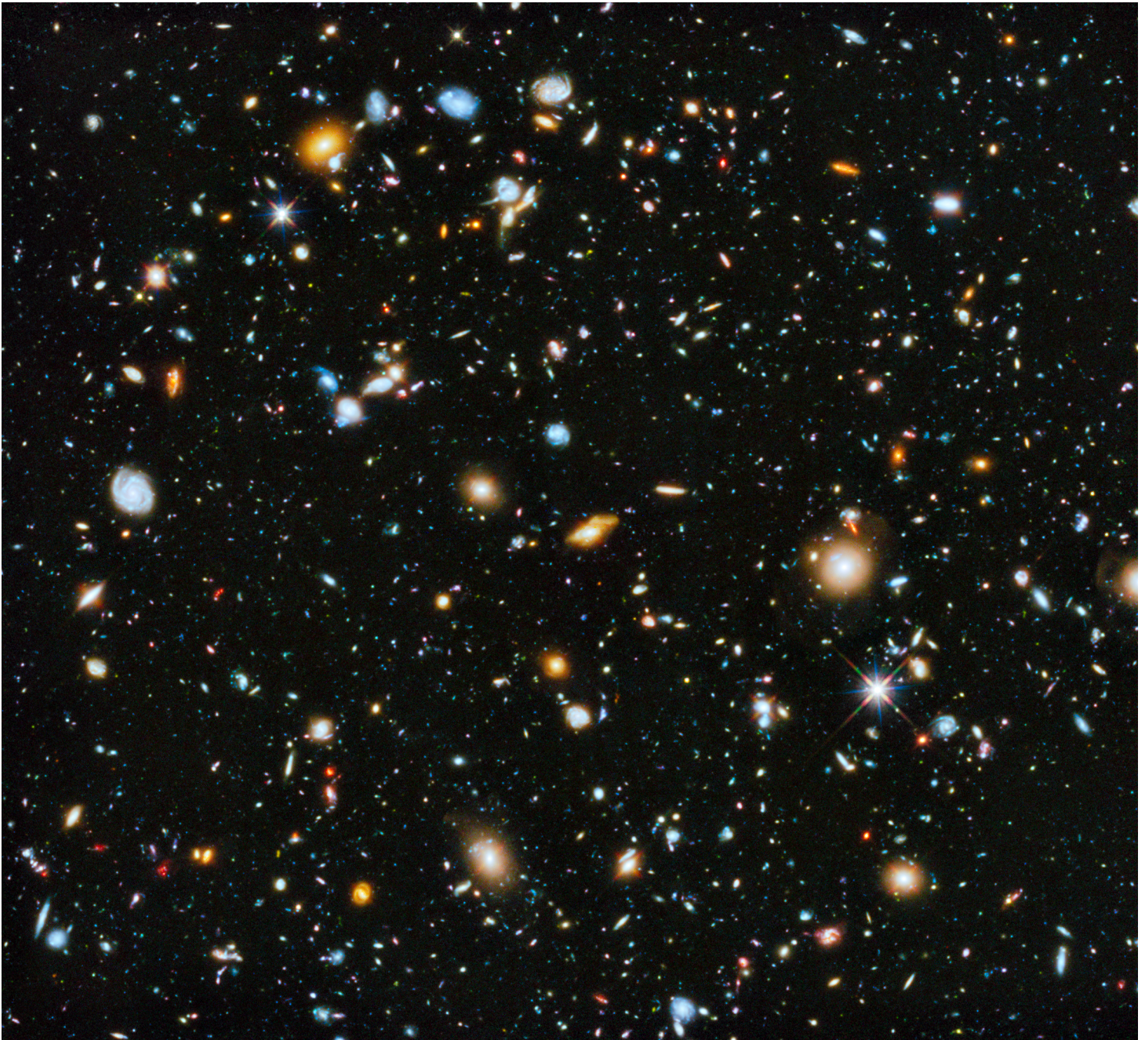
St. Francis of Assisi Preaching to the Birds

This paragraph was about a conversation in his youth.

“I was walking home with one my companions, (...) the sky studded with stars.” (...) “I said to him: ‘What was God doing before He created the world? Why did He create it?’ He replied, ‘See here! Stop that! If you begin thinking about such things, you will lose your mind.’”

(...)

“But I must confess that after a half century of my life had passed, I returned to the study of the world’s creation. This time also I consulted a companion, but one very different from that fellow schoolboy — the Holy Spirit Himself, whose voice is heard in the heart of every one of us. An answer was given me that took possession of my mind: God is Love; for pure love, God made the world.”

Interestingly, the six-pointed star itself is not unique to Jewish, Islam, and Christianity, the major Abrahamic, monotheistic religions.

That hexagram is a regular star polygon which has found in ancient civilizations from India and Mesopotamia to Greece and Rome. Several variations of the hexagram can be found in archaeological studies about diverse cultures and religions.

The symbol's story was beginning
when the star was over the Garden of Eden.
It was shiny there before the first / original sin when people adore the
Creator.

The Canticle of the Creation Prayer was first published in the
CANTICLE of the CREATION.

In it described a cluster / group of six stars.

They were named as this:

- The Creator's Star / the Star of Creation / the Star of David;
- the Star of Jacob (Num. 24:17);
- the Child's Star over the silent night in Bethlehem (cf. Mt. 2:2,10);
- Our Lady, the Star of the Sea points her Son ...
- you shine like stars in the world (cf. Phil. 2:15);
- Jesus is "the bright morning star" (Rev. 22:26).

Hopefully, consider / ponder this information because
it is helpful to many:

As the ancient Star of David is a six-pointed One.
Each one of the above six stars would represent one of its points.

Furthermore, in the Star of David
contains six large equilateral triangles,
and six smaller equilateral triangles,
would represent the six stars in the cluster.
